WHO WE ARE

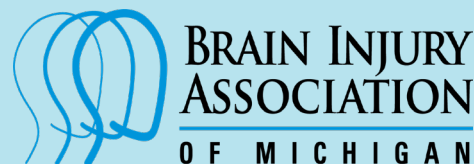
